


Why Rezone in District 20?

- Over-utilization, capping, and zoned K waitlists at P.S. 247.
- The Academy of Talented Scholars (TAOTS), located 0.5 miles from P.S. 247, is currently non-zoned.
- The creation of a zone for TAOTS out of part of the existing P.S. 247 zone aims to address over-utilization, capping, and waitlists at P.S. 247.



Rezoning Process and Timeline





Rezoning Policies

When: Pending approval by the CEC in Fall 2017, proposed changes would take effect for the 2018-2019 academic year.

Who: Proposed changes would primarily impact incoming kindergarten or new students to the system. All currently enrolled students in grades K-5 may remain in their school until graduation.

Standard Admissions Policies: All impacted schools will continue to admit students according to Chancellor's Regulation A-101.

Standard Busing Policies: The Office of Pupil Transportation will follow standard procedure to determine bus service eligibility of general education students, as outlined by Chancellor's Regulation A-801.



Sibling Grandfathering

- Children entering kindergarten with a sibling in grades K-5 at P.S. 247 will maintain their zoned sibling priority
- All children entering kindergarten with a sibling in grades K-5 at TAOTS will receive zoned sibling priority for admissions.



Rezoning Methodology

Steps:

- 1. Determine the Target Kindergarten Zone Size for each school
- 2. Project future kindergarten residents at the block level
- 3. Draft new zone line scenarios



Drawing the Zone Lines

- > Total of projected kindergarteners from each block = Target Zone Size
- Strive to have the school located within the zone boundaries
- > Equalize or maintain diversity of zone populations
- > Avoid geographic barriers to travel
- > Minimize travel distance (when possible)






Current Zone Lines

Appendix A.2: Admissions Process¹: Kindergarten

Students will be enrolled in New York City elementary schools by the following priority:

- Zoned students whose verified siblings are pre-registered or enrolled at the time of application submission and will be enrolled in grades K-5 in the school at the start of the following school year
- 2. Zoned students other than those in (1) above applying to the zoned school
- Students whose verified siblings are pre-registered or enrolled at the time of application submission and will be enrolled in grades K-5 in the school at the start of the following school year who are not zoned to the school,

a. Within District first, then

b. Out of District

- 4. Students currently attending the school's pre-kindergarten program who reside outside the school's zone, *without* a sibling who will be in grades K-5 at the school in the following school year,
 - a. Within District first, then
 - b. Out of District
- 5. Students other than those in (3a) and (4a) above who are residents of that district
- 6. Students other than those in (3b) and (4b) who are residents of another district

Appendix G: Rezoning Engagement

Engagement with impacted community members were held on:

- March 28th: ODP met with Superintendent Karina Costantino and CEC 20 leadership to discuss potential need to zone The Academy of Talented Scholars and rezone P.S. 247.
- **May 2nd:** ODP met with representatives from CEC 20, impacted principals and SLTs from P.S. 247 and The Academy of Talented Scholars to examine existing zone lines and share rationale for rezoning, rezoning process and timelines, and obtain feedback and answer questions about a potential rezoning.
- **May 22nd**: ODP held joint SLT meeting with P.S. 247 and The Academy of Talented Scholars SLTs to share initial draft map of potential zone lines.
- **September 18th:** ODP presents an official rezoning scenario to CEC 20.
