



CITYWIDE SPECIAL CLASS ENROLLMENT, 2018-19 TO 2023-24






• The number of District 75 students in special classes has increased by approximately 11% in the last five years.

DISTRICT 75 ENROLLMENT BY BOROUGH

District 75 Special Class Enrollment by Borough 2021-22 to 2023-24



- In all boroughs, the number of students enrolled in District 75 special classes increased over last three years.
- The number of students in Manhattan, Queens, and Staten Island enrolled in District 75 special classes each increased by about 11% over the last two years. The number of students in Brooklyn and the Bronx grew by 8% and 6%, respectively.

DISTRICT PLANNING PROCESS

- The Office of District Planning partners with superintendents and communities to address
 district needs in accordance with Chancellor's Regulation A-190, which governs the process to
 make any major changes to school utilization such as co-locations and re-sitings. A-190
 proposals are voted on by the Panel for Educational Policy (PEP).
- The tables below show all District 75-related proposals approved by the PEP that are implementing in the 2022-2023, 2023-2024, and 2024-2025 school years, as well as new sites in new or standalone buildings, which are not subject to the A-190 process.




- Building K464, a new school building scheduled to open for the 2024-2025 school year, will house an 11-section District 75 middle school program (75K231), to help address the seat need in District 20.
- During the 2024-2025 school year, the Office of District Planning anticipates identifying space for expanding existing District 75 programs and/or opening new sites for implementation in September 2025.

District 75 ES Residents, 2023-24




• The above chart shows the number of District 75 elementary school residents by district who receive special class services.

DISTRICT 75 SPECIAL CLASS SEAT NEED

- This section shows special class students and seats on the borough level and district levels, not including changes planned to implement in the 2024-2025 school year and beyond.
- District 75 placements are assessed on a borough basis, with consideration for students' individual special education needs, physical accessibility requirements, and district of residence, as well as seat availability and whether the student has a sibling at a specific site.
- Guiding Questions:
 - o Does the district have a need for more District 75 seats?
 - Are there potential options for new District 75 sites to provide opportunities for students to attend programs closer to their homes?



- Based on 2023-24 data, each borough has enough seats on aggregate compared with the total number of
 District 75 students in special classes. However, because seat student enrollment and capacity varies
 across each borough, district-level enrollment and seat need data help illustrate which districts may be in
 need of additional seats.
- In all districts, the need for specific, recommended program types, class sizes, and grade levels may not align with existing capacity and the overall excess or deficit of seats.
 - This is especially relevant in District 31 (Staten Island), where District 75 students have less access to programs in other boroughs due to geography.

DISTRICT 75 ES SEAT NEED BY DISTRICT

 The charts below compare the number of District 75 special class seats at the elementary, middle school, and high school levels within a given district with the number of district residents who require District 75 special class services, and includes districts that show a deficit of seats in 2023-2024.




District 75 ES Seat Need, 2023-24

- In 2023-2024, District 9 in the Bronx had the largest special class seat deficit at the ES level (389).
 - A new District 75 elementary school program opening in District 9 in Building X496 is expected to help reduce the district's seat deficit.
- New District 75 programs opened in 2023-2024 in Districts 6 and 29 helped to eliminate the elementary school seat deficit in those districts (see p. 4 for full listing).
- Building X105 will receive an addition in the 2025-26 school year, including space for a 10-section D75 elementary school program, which will help address seat need in District 11.

DISTRICT 75 MS SEAT NEED BY DISTRICT




District 75 MS Seat Need, 2023-24

- In 2023-2024, District 27 in Queens had the largest special class seat deficit at the MS level (147), followed closely by District 20 in Brooklyn.
- New sites in District 24 at Q419 and in District 10 at X045 added District 75 middle school capacity in the 2023-2024 school year. (see p. 4 for full listing).
- New District 75 middle school sites opening at K218 in District 19 and in new buildings K322 and K464 in District 20 in the 2024-2025 school year will help reduce the seat deficits in those districts.

- District 9 in the Bronx continues to have the largest special class seat deficit at the HS level (432).
- The opening of new District 75 programs in buildings M218 in District 6 and K415 in District 18 helped reduce high school seat deficits in those districts.
- The new high school District 75 programs planned to open in District 19 at building K218 and District 29 at building Q420 in the 2024-2025 school year will help address the seat need in those districts.
- Building improvements at Building K909 in District 17 will allow 75K373 to expand by five high school sections when the program is re-sited back to the building for the 2024-2025 school year.
- In 2028-2029 planned new capacity at Building K382 in District 20 will include space for a new 12section District 75 high school program.

DISTRICT 75 CAPACITY PROJECTS

- The table below reflects District 75 projects and new capacity projects with designed District 75 seats, per the NYC School Construction Authority as of July 2023.
- District 75 capacity for these projects is based on a maximum capacity figure of 12 students per class; the actual number of seats may be smaller if classes with lower class sizes are opened in these new buildings.
