Early Childhood Programs

3-K AND PRE-K

ELIGIBILITY

- ☐ Students can enroll in 3-K in the calendar year they turn three.
- ☐ Students can enroll in Pre-K in the calendar year they turn four.
- ☐ Some 3-K and Pre-K programs offer year-round care and education for up to 10 hours a day to students who qualify based on family income and needs.

HOW TO ENROLL

- Families can explore options online by visiting [MySchools.nyc](https://www.schools.nyc.gov/3K) to access the 3-K and Pre-K directories.
- Within each directory, use the filter titled "Need a seat for this school year?" to see which schools may have seats available.
- Be sure to enter your address to find schools close to home.
- You can contact schools directly to confirm availability and enroll.

Elementary School Through Middle School

GRADES K-8

ELIGIBILITY

- ☐ Students can enroll in kindergarten in the calendar year they turn five.
- ☐ Students can enroll in first grade in the calendar year they turn six.
- ☐ Students who need to enroll in grades 2 through 8.

HOW TO ENROLL

- Find out if you have a zoned school by visiting schoolsearch.schools.nyc and entering your address or by calling **311**.
- Have a zoned school? Enroll directly at that school; find out how and when by contacting or visiting them.
- Don't have a zoned school? Contact schools directly or visit a Family Welcome Center (FWC). To learn more, visit schools.nyc.gov/FWC.



High School

GRADES 9–12

ELIGIBILITY

- ☐ Students who need to enroll in grades 9 through 12.
- ☐ Students who are at least 15 years old with no recent educational records can enroll in high school.

HOW TO ENROLL

- Contact a Family Welcome Center to enroll. To learn more, visit schools.nyc.gov/FWC.
- Prepare the following documents:
 - Proof of your child's age (birth certificate, passport, or record of baptism)
 - Your child's immunization record (if available)
 - Your child's latest report card/transcript (if available)
 - Two documents verifying proof of address—find examples of accepted documents at on.nyc.gov/RegistrationChecklist

Families in temporary housing are not required to provide documentation in order to enroll.

Looking for Options for Children Aged 6 Weeks to 2 Years?

Year-round infant and toddler programs are available for children aged 6 weeks to 2 years old, for up to 10 hours a day. Eligibility is based on income and family needs. Learn more at on.nyc.gov/BrightStarts.

Applying for the Next School Year?

If you are looking for a school for the next school year, you can submit an application during the application period for the following grade levels: 3-K, Pre-K, kindergarten, sixth and ninth grade. At that time, you can visit MySchools.nyc to access the online directory and application portal.
